

ALERT: SOCIAL SECURITY ISSUE

Continuing Benefits During COVID-19

Social Security has created a temporary rule that applies during the COVID-19 pandemic to help when benefit payments have stopped. This rule applies to you if all of the following are true:

- You received a notice ending your benefits because of an unfavorable determination a Continuing Disability Review;
- The date of the notice of cessation from Social Security is on or before August 30, 2020; AND
- You appealed Social Security's decision by filing a Request for Reconsideration, **but** you did not request that your benefits continue.

If this applies to you, Social Security will find that there is “good cause” for your benefits to continue during your appeal. Contact your local Social Security office to request that your benefits continue. [Click here to read the emergency rule on Social Security's website.](#)
